RE: Informal Conference of April 10, 2026

Pursuant to an Order issued on April 3, 2026, an informal conference (IC) was conducted on April 10, 2026. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The IC was requested by East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (EKPC). The purpose of the IC was to discuss issues related to the rehearing proceeding in this matter.

Amanda Lawson opened the meeting by stating that Staff could not speak for the Commission and that the meeting was limited to discussion of issues in Case No. 2025-00053. Participants then introduced themselves and representatives of EKPC were invited to begin the discussion.

Representatives of EKPC discussed the environmental surcharge mechanism issue that is the subject of rehearing and provided additional explanation regarding the operation and replacement of the air heater baskets at issue. Staff asked questions regarding the operation of the equipment, environmental compliance considerations, and the relationship between the replacement project and environmental controls. Representatives of EKPC responded to questions from Staff and provided additional clarification regarding EKPC's position.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
