**Kentucky Power Company’s Request to Submit Matter for Decision on the Record**

In accordance with the Public Service Commission of Kentucky’s (“Commission”) May 14, 2026, Order, Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power” or “Company”) respectfully requests that this matter be submitted for decision on the record and without a hearing. In support of its request, Kentucky Power states as follows:

Complainant Terri Hurley filed her formal complaint against Kentucky Power on March 5, 2025. In response to the Commission’s August 15, 2025, order Ms. Hurley filed a response to support the claims in her complaint on August 19, 2025. On October 2, 2025, the Commission ordered that Kentucky Power file its response to Ms. Hurley’s complaint, which the Company did, along with its Motion to Dismiss, on October 13, 2025. Commission Staff submitted its first set of data requests to Kentucky Power on February 5, 2026, to which the Company responded on February 24, 2026. Commission Staff then submitted its second set of data requests to Kentucky Power on March 11, 2026, to which the Company responded on March 23, 2026. Commission Staff then submitted its third set of data requests to Kentucky Power on May 26, 2026, to which it responded on June 8, 2026. Commission Staff also submitted one set of data request to Ms. Hurley

on May 27, 2026, to which she responded on the same day. The procedural schedule appended to the Commission's May 14, 2026, order provides that Kentucky Power may request a hearing or to submit this matter for a decision on the record on June 15, 2026.

Kentucky Power contends that the record in this case has been sufficiently developed and, therefore, respectfully requests that this matter be submitted for decision on the record as of the date of this filing.

However, the Company will defer to the Commission if the Commission or Commission Staff determine that a hearing is needed or would be beneficial to supplement the record of this matter with additional evidence so that the complaint may be resolved. In that event, the Company will make its witnesses available for any such hearing at the convenience of the Commission. The Company is also willing to attend an Informal Conference with Commission Staff and Ms. Hurley to discuss any outstanding issues, any evidence submitted, or to discuss any other matters that would aid in the handling and disposition of the case.
