ORDER

On September 2, 2025, Kentucky-American Water Company (Kentucky-American) filed a motion for its witness, Michael Adams, to appear virtually at the September 23, 2025 hearing in this matter. In support of the motion, Kentucky-American stated that Mr. Adams has a professional scheduling conflict that would create an undue hardship on Mr. Adams if he must travel to Kentucky for the hearing.¹ Additionally, Kentucky-American noted that the Attorney General and Lexington-Fayette County Government did not oppose the request.²

Having considered the motion and facts, the Commission finds good cause to grant the motion because Mr. Adams has a professional scheduling conflict, which would create hardship to travel to Kentucky and the parties do not oppose the request. Mr. Adams should be authorized to participate virtually at the September 23, 2025 hearing. Staff shall coordinate with counsel prior to the hearing to ensure that the witness is provided a link for remote participation.
