Dear Public Service Commission:

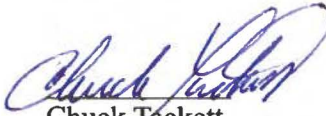

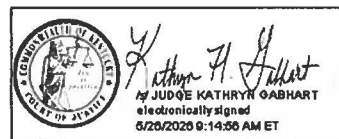
