This is an application to revise East Casey County Water District's tariff to include a revision to when payments must be received to not incur a late payment penalty and a provision allowing for customers to pay their bills by credit/debit card. The credit card processing company will charge a convenience fee directly to the customer. The fee will not be collected by East Casey County Water District. Attached is the proposed tariff sheet.

The District will publish the enclosed public notice of the proposed tariff change in the local newspaper for three consecutive weeks starting April 30, 2025. We will follow up with an affidavit from the newspaper verifying that the notice was published for three consecutive weeks.

## NOTICE

### TARIFF ADJUSTMENT

East Casey County Water District plans on filing with the Public Service Commission, no later than May 1, 2025, to revise its tariff to include a revision to when payments must be received to not incur a late payment penalty and a provision for payment of customer bills by credit/debit card. The proposed effective date of the changes is June 1, 2025. The proposed revisions will state:

Payment must be received, not postmarked, before the close of business on the ~~twentieth day from the date of issue~~ tenth day from the date of issue; otherwise, the delinquent bill will be assessed the late payment penalty approved and on-file with the Public Service Commission.

Customers may make payment by credit or debit card in person at the District's office or by telephone. If payment by credit or debit card is attempted and declined, the customer's obligation to pay the bill amount on the due date remains unchanged. Credit card payments are subject to a convenience fee assessed directly by the card processor (not the District) to the customer. Prior to processing the transaction, the customer will be informed of the fee amount.

The provision contained in this notice is the provision proposed by East Casey County Water District. However, the Public Service Commission may order a provision that differs from the proposed revision.

A person may submit a timely written request for intervention to the Public Service Commission, P.O. 615, Frankfort, KY 40602, establishing the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party. If the Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty days of the initial publication of this notice, the Commission may take final action on the tariff filing.

A person may examine this filing and any other documents the District has filed with the Public Service Commission at the District's office located at 690 Wallace Wilkinson Blvd., Liberty, KY 42539; telephone (606) 787-9961. A person may also examine this tariff filing at the Commission's office located at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort Kentucky, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. This filing and any related documents are available on the Public Service Commission's Web site at <http://psc.ky.gov>;

Written comments regarding the proposed rate may be submitted to the Public Service Commission by mail or through the Public Service Commission's Web site.



- d) Payment must be received, not postmarked, before the close of business on the tenth day from the (T) date of issue; otherwise, the delinquent bill will be assessed the late payment penalty approved and on-file with the Public Service Commission.
- e) The late payment penalty will be assessed on the delinquent amount of the bill, less taxes and any prior penalty amounts. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:006 Section 9 (3)(h), a penalty may be assessed (T) only once on any bill for rendered services.
- f) Customers may make payment by credit or debit card in person at the District's office or by (N) telephone. If payment by credit or debit card is attempted and declined, the customer's obligation (N) to pay the bill amount on the due date remains unchanged. Credit card payments are subject to a (N) convenience fee assessed directly by the card processor (not the District) to the customer. Prior to (N) processing the transaction, the customer will be informed of the fee amount. (N)
- g) With the exception of existing connections, the existence of special contract, or unusual circumstances requiring approval of the utility, a single meter can serve no more than one residential or commercial unit on and after the effective date of this tariff.
- h) For existing connection, special contracts, or other utility approved situations, where two or more units are being served by one meter, the following rules will apply:
- 1) One bill per meter will be sent to the customer that signed the Water Service Contract.
  - 2) The bill will consist of a charge in the amount of the utility's minimum bill multiplied by the number of units the meter serves. The amount of water included with a minimum bill will be multiplied by the number of units and deducted from the total amount of consumption. The remaining consumption will be evenly distributed among each unit, added to each unit's minimum bill, with the charges calculated in accordance with the currently approved rate schedule.
  - 3) The customer that signed the Water Service Contract will be fully and solely responsible for the charges associated with the connection including payment for all water passing through the meter, regardless of which unit is responsible for the water consumption.
