As the Chair of the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC), I also serve as the Chair of the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting (Siting Board). Therefore, it is my duty to inform you that, on June 30, 2025, the Siting Board received a Notice of Intent from Barrelhead Solar, LLC requesting a certificate to construct an approximately 54-megawatt merchant electric generation facility in Wayne County, Kentucky.

Barrelhead Solar, LLC ("Barrelhead") hereby submits for filing this Notice of Intent to file an application for a Certificate of Construction for an approximately 54 MW solar facility ("Barrelhead Project").

b. The proposed construction is briefly described as follows:

The facility will be located on approximately 378 acres of privately owned land and consist of solar panels and associated racking (approximately 54 MW), inverters, electric equipment, project substation and transformer, utility switching station, transmission line, underground electrical connection lines, and related equipment.



- c. The proposed Barrelhead Project will be located approximately 0.64 miles northeast of Alpha and 0.46 miles northwest of Happy Top. The latitude and longitude are approximately 36.778364° N, 85.006984° W. The Barrelhead Project is not located within the limits of any city. It will be located in Wayne County.
- d. There is no planning commission with jurisdiction over this site.
- e. There are no setback requirements established by a planning and zoning commission.
- f. There are no schools, hospitals, or nursing home facilities within 2,000 feet of the project. Nevertheless, it appears there are two residential neighborhoods within 2,000 feet of the project. Accordingly, the applicant will request a deviation from the setback requirements found in KRS 278.704(2).
