ORDER

On July 18, 2025, Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District (Jessamine-South Elkhorn District) applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the treated sewage adjustment procedure set forth in KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:075. On August 11, 2025, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District submitted documentation amending its application.¹

LEGAL STANDARD

In accordance with KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:075, which govern treated sewage adjustment filings, a jurisdictional utility may increase its rates to pass through a wholesale provider's rate increase. Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:075 authorizes a water district to file a treated sewage adjustment no earlier than 30 days prior to the proposed effective date of a wholesale provider's changed rate or no later than 20 days after the wholesale provider changes its rate. KRS 278.015 requires the Commission to approve a treated sewage adjustment no later than 30 days after a district files notice of a rate increase from its wholesale provider and the volume of sewage treated used to calculate the increase in rates.

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS

Jessamine-South Elkhorn District purchases wastewater treatment services from Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG). LFUCG notified Jessamine-South Elkhorn District that its wholesale sewage treatment rate would increase from \$8.26 per 100 cubic feet to \$8.45 per 100 cubic feet, effective July 1, 2025.²

As described below, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District proposed to increase the sewer rates to its customers to reflect the increased cost of wastewater treatment from LFUCG. Jessamine-South Elkhorn proposed to increase current rates to be effective July 1, 2025.

Financial Condition and Rates

Jessamine-South Elkhorn District's last alternative rate adjustment filing was Case No. 2022-00053 (2020 test year), which resulted in an increase of \$270,193 or 26.93 percent.³ The increase approved in Case No. 2022-00053 was phased in over two years starting from the final Order date of August 25, 2022.⁴ Rate based income (adjusted net income minus principal payments) was negative each year (2020-2024), although it improved in 2023 and 2024 as a result of the rate increase from Case No. 2022-00053. Cash basis income (rate based income plus depreciation) was negative in 2020 but was positive from 2021 through 2024. A chart summarizing cash basis and rate based income is presented below.

In Case No. 2024-00206, the Commission recommended that Jessamine-South Elkhorn District file a revenue sufficiency analysis no later than June 30, 2025, based on 2024 financial results and that it consider filing a rate adjustment application soon thereafter if the result is negative.⁵ On May 7, 2025, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District filed a Revenue Sufficiency Analysis for its sewer system, prepared by the Kentucky Rural Water Association.⁶ The analysis indicates that the current sewer division rates of Jessamine-South Elkhorn District are sufficient.⁷

Based on review of the 2024 Annual Report⁸ and the Revenue Sufficiency Analysis, the Commission recommends Jessamine-South Elkhorn District monitor its

operating performance annually and consider filing future rate cases every three to five years depending on financial performance.

Treated Sewage Adjustment Factor

In its application, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District proposed a treated sewage adjustment factor of \$0.26 per 1,000 gallons.⁹ During the 12 months ended May 31, 2025, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District's sewer customers receiving service from LFUCG used 13,076,689.72 cubic feet¹⁰ of water (97,820,439¹¹ gallons of water). The increase in the cost of treated sewage from LFUCG is \$24,845.71, resulting in a treated sewage adjustment factor of \$0.26 per 1,000 gallons.¹² In its application, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District erroneously listed its current rate for "All Over 2,000 Gallons" as \$17.805 per 1,000 gallons,¹³ instead of the correct tariff rate of \$17.68 per 1,000 gallons, leading to an incorrect proposed rate for that tier. Jessamine-South Elkhorn District subsequently filed an amended Exhibit C, Rate Schedule on August 11, 2025, with the corrected current and proposed rates.¹⁴

The Commission finds that the treated sewage adjustment factor of \$0.26 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A, and the rates set forth in Appendix B to this Order are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved for sewer service rendered by Jessamine-South Elkhorn District on and after July 1, 2025, because the rates are

supported by evidence of the increase in rates from Jessamine-South Elkhorn District's wholesale sewage treatment provider and the volume of wastewater treatment used to calculate the rates in accordance with KRS 278.015.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The treated sewage adjustment factor of \$0.26 per 1,000 gallons is approved.
 - 2. The rates proposed by Jessamine-South Elkhorn District are approved.
- 3. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by Jessamine-South Elkhorn District on and after July 1, 2025.
- 4. Within 20 days of the date of service of this Order, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
 - 5. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
