

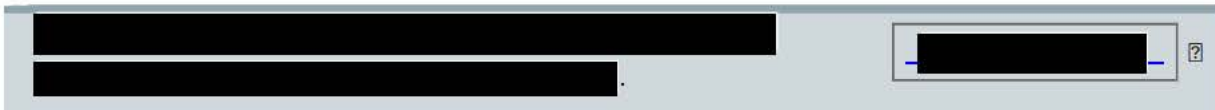

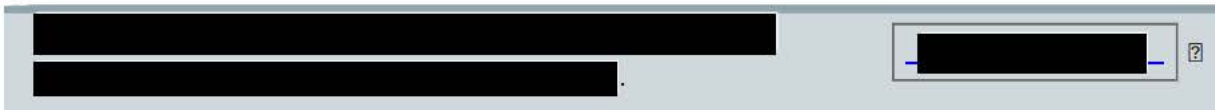

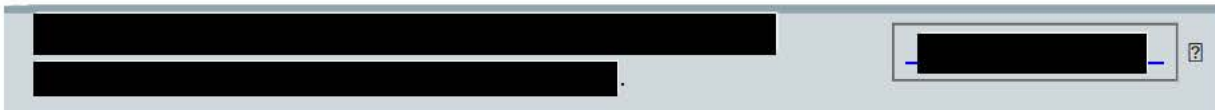

I think it's wrong. Taking away good farmland. Put it on tops of wal marts or lowes where it won't hurt people or crops that people depend on for food

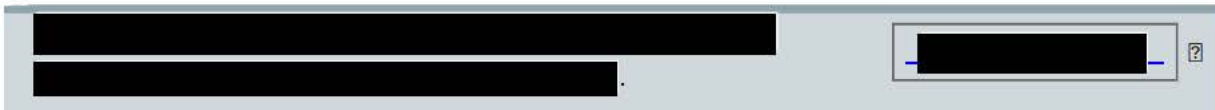
