RE: Informal Conference of February 5, 2026

Pursuant to Commission Staff's Notice issued on February 4, 2026, an Informal Conference (IC) was conducted on February 5, 2026, at 2:30 pm. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was for the parties to provide assistance and clarity regarding the application and attachments for the transmission line that East Kentucky Power Cooperative (EKPC) has proposed and is seeking a CPCN.

EKPC explained that internal studies were conducted once need for transmission line was identified, and at that time, a single circuit line looked sufficient. Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) verified the results but found some overloads. Both EKPC and LG&E realized that a double circuit line would be needed, and changes were made during the scope of the project. PJM has since studied the data and is in agreement that the double circuit line is the right project for the area.

EKPC stated it updated the siting study to from evaluation of a single circuit line to the double circuit line scoring. Route B remained the preferred route in all three categories, and now scores third best in engineering perspective.

Finally, EKPC admitted confusion was due to a clerical errors on the part of EKPC that carried through between the original single line proposal and the adjusted double line proposal as well as a typo related to the length of the line. Redline versions and modest centerline adjustments will be made in corrections to be filed with the response to Commission Staff's Third Data Request due on February 6, 2026.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
