INTRA-AGENCY MEMORANDUM

KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

RE: Informal Conference of September 10, 2026

Pursuant to a Staff Notice issued on August 24, 2026, an informal conference was conducted on September 10, 2026. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the informal conference was to discuss Governor Beshear's Executive Order (EO) 2026-494, including any impact on this case.

The parties presented the following positions:

Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) and Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) (jointly LG&E/KU)

LG&E/KU stated that they do not think the EO has any impact on this proceeding or the CPCN that was granted for Mill Creek 6. LG&E/KU does not expect to request cost recovery until 2031, when the unit is expected to be in-service. LG&E/KU recognized there will be a time when cost recovery will be at issue and whether the directives of the EO apply to this particularly. LG&E/KU did not think that any additional steps needed to be added to the procedural schedule in this matter and did not think that briefs were necessary.

Attorney General

The Attorney General highlighted that the Commission is a creature of statute and has no additional powers than those the legislature has given it. The Attorney General argued that the EO is not relevant to this proceeding, and there is no need to change the procedural Order or brief this issue. The Attorney General agreed with its intent that data centers should not increase costs to ratepayers, and argued that having data centers come to Kentucky, if done properly, could actually lower people's rates, not raise them.

Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers Inc. (KIUC)

KIUC echoed LG&E/KU and the Attorney General, stated the EO had no effect on this case. KIUC did not think additional changes were needed to the procedural schedule.

Sierra Club

Sierra Club stated that the procedural schedule is working as it is intended. Sierra Club stated that this is a docket where the Commission is tracking the costs for Mill Creek 6,

and that the EO limits what the Commission is allowed to approve regarding cost recovery and in that respect the EO is relevant.

Joint Intervenors

Joint Intervenors stated that this docket requires transparency and prudence to the expenses being borne. Joint Intervenors raised questions regarding the progress of Mill Creek 6 in terms of the Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) contract and increasing project element price pressures. Joint Intervenors stated that they have continued issues with the economic development queue. Joint Intervenors requested a data request prior to the October 14, 2026 informal conference (IC) related to the upcoming EPC contract.

Louisville Metro

Louisville Metro stated that it had no position.

KCA

KCA agreed with Attorney General and LG&E/KU.

KYSEIA

KYSEIA stated that the current procedural schedule is fine, without comments on the substance of the matter. KYSEIA raised the question of how costs related to Mill Creek 6 are being carried on the books. KYSEIA asked whether a change to the process is needed to identify the costs that are being recorded.

Other Comments

LG&E/KU thought it would be premature to add another round of data requests especially with only two weeks to respond. No other parties took a position. LG&E/KU stated that they were confident in the need for the generation Mill Creek 6 will provide. LG&E/KU said costs are accounted for through Allowance for Funds Used During Construction (AFUDC) and does not affect customer rates during its construction.

There being no further discussion, the informal conference was then adjourned.
