I AM SUBMITTING A WRITTEN REQUEST FOR INTERVENTION AGAINST THE BLUEGRASS WATER COMPANY ON BEHALF OF THE RESIDENTS AT MAGRUDER VILLAGE, KEVIN, KY, 42053. I WAS INFORMED IN THE LAST PART OF DECEMBER THAT BLUEGRASS WAS ATTEMPTING TO INCREASE OUR BILL FROM \$35 TO \$114.00, THAT IS A 225.7% INCREASE FROM THE FIRST YEAR OF SERVICE TO THE SECOND. IT WAS STATED TO INCREASE PROFITS BY \$2,669,423.86. THIS IS TOO MUCH!
