RE: Case No. 2025-00354 – Opposition to Bluegrass Water Rate Increase

Date: January 13, 2026

To the Kentucky Public Service Commission,

I am writing to formally express my strong opposition to the rate adjustment requested by Bluegrass Water Utility Operating Company, LLC, as filed on December 11, 2025. The proposed increase for residential customers from **\$77.77** to **\$114.00**—a **46.6% hike**—represents an undue financial burden on our community.

This request is particularly concerning given the history of this system. Prior to Bluegrass Water's acquisition, many residents paid approximately **\$24.00 or less** per month. The rapid escalation from those levels to the current \$77.77, and now to a proposed \$114.00, is unsustainable for families and those on fixed incomes.

While the company cites infrastructure upgrades as justification, these costs should not be recovered through such aggressive and frequent increases that far outpace the cost of similar services in neighboring municipal districts. I request that the PSC:

1. **Deny** the proposed increase in its entirety.
2. **Investigate** the necessity and cost-effectiveness of the "planned improvements" cited by the company.
3. **Consider** the cumulative impact of these rapid increases on the "fair, just, and reasonable" standard for utility rates.
