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Dear Commissioners,

I previously submitted public comments on this case on Jan 16, 2026. I am writing again to oppose Bluegrass Water Utility Operating Company's proposed wastewater rate increase for Persimmon Ridge.

The proposed increase would raise our monthly bill from \$77.77 to \$111.72- a 43.7% increase or more than \$400 additional per year for wastewater service alone

I understand that Bluegrass Water has made improvements to their systems and that infrastructure must be maintained. My concern is whether the full amount of this increase for Persimmon Ridge is justified.

Testimony filed on behalf of the Kentucky Attorney General raises several concerns about the expenses included in the Bluegrass Water's request, including late fee overcollections, prior rate-case expenses, unsupported bad debt assumptions and

allocated wastewater costs. The Attorney General's analysis supports a sustainably smaller revenue increase than Bluegrass Water has requested.

I respectfully ask the Commision to carefully review these costs, exclude any expenses that are unsupported or unreasonable, return any overcollections to customers and approve only the amount that is clearly supported by the documented evidence.

Persimmon Ridge should pay a fair rate for reliable wastewater service but **a 43.7% increase deserves very careful scrutiny.**

Thank you for your consideration and your commitment to protecting Kentucky consumers. I appreciate the opportunity to submit these comments for the Commission's review.
