**NOTICE OF SATISFACTION AND MOTION TO DISMISS OF**  
**LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY**

Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”), by counsel, respectfully asks the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to dismiss with prejudice the Complaint of Gregory Allen (“Complainant”) because LG&E has fully satisfied the Complaint.

On August 11, 2025, the Complainant contacted LG&E to have his rate checked on his account for the property located at 233 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Shepherdsville, Kentucky 40165 (“Property”). At the time he contacted LG&E, his account was billed at the GS Single Phase rate. A rate check service order was entered on August 13, 2025 and later completed on September 11, 2025 confirming the Property met the requirements for a residence. LG&E updated the account to residential and reversed the Complainant’s September bill, which covered meter readings from August 4, 2025 to September 3, 2025, to rebill his account on a residential rate and align with the appropriate billing periods.

Complainant submitted an informal complaint to the Commission on September 18, 2025 (#2025-01645) seeking additional refund amounts. LG&E responded and provided its reasoning

supporting its decision to issue a refund in an amount of the refund relative to when it received notice from the Complainant.

The Complainant then filed this formal Complaint on November 14, 2025. By Order dated April 29, 2026, LG&E was ordered to satisfy the matters complained of or file an answer.

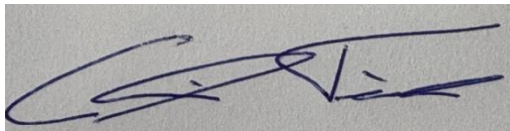
In responding to this Complaint, LG&E investigated the matter further. LG&E further learned that prior to the Complainant contacting LG&E and placing service into his name on February 7, 2025, the account was in the name of a limited liability company and was being billed on the GS Single Phase rate. On his call to begin service in his name, Complainant indicated that he was going to use the Property as his personal residence. Given these facts, the account should have been subjected to a rate check at that time that would have likely discovered that the Property should be on the RS rate. Accordingly, and based on this additional information, LG&E agrees to adjust the account to RS as of February 7, 2025 and to refund the Complainant the disputed amount between February 7, 2025 and August 4, 2025.

LG&E's Customer Commitment department has attempted to contact Complainant to confirm this is a successful resolution of the Complaint, but has not yet been able to reach him. However, given that the resolution provides Complainant the relief he requested, LG&E believes that dismissal of the Complaint is appropriate.

**WHEREFORE**, for all of the reasons set forth above, Louisville Gas and Electric Company respectfully asks the Commission to dismiss the Complaint with prejudice and remove the case from the docket.

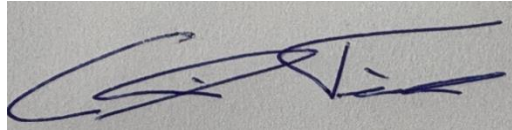
