To whom it may concern,

My name is David Brian Wilder, I reside at 76 Money Lane, 5 miles outside the city of Pineville KY. My house and property boundary with Clear Creek Baptist School. This letter is in response to a letter I received from Pike Legal informing me that a company named New Cingular Wireless has filed an application to erect a 255 foot cell phone tower on the property of Clear Creek Babtist College that does boundary my property. This tower would be less than 500 feet from my residence and less that 200 feet from my property line. I am writing this letter to express my opposition to the construction of this tower.

How will this tower affect my personal life? All cell towers have flashing bright strobe lights located on different elevations of the tower. Flashing strobe lights from this tower will be directed into my two front bedrooms and living room. Therefore, when I lay down in my bed at night to sleep instead of counting sheep I will be counting the strobes from the flashing lights. I chose this location to build my home because it is in a private remote area halfway up a mountain in Clear Creek completely surrounded and enclosed by trees that shields me from other houses, cars, lights and highways and in complete darkness and privacy. I haven't installed curtains or blinds on any window in my home due to having complete privacy as well as no distractions from any outside entity, just peace, quiet and darkness. The only illumination I am exposed to at night is the starlite sky. In the summer time as I sit on my front porch I am in complete darkness, peace and tranquility. When this tower is erected I will be looking straight into strobing lights 250 feet away.


The installation of this cell tower will also devalue the worth of my property. I have talked to a property and residential advisor that has informed me that this tower will definitely affect the value of my property. Therefore not only is it causing me stress and discomfort from the lights it is affecting my financial wealth. I have plans to build a cabin on my lower property for my son to live in, this cabin which will be located within 200 feet of this tower, therefore exposing him with the issues of the flashing strobe lights and all the discomforts it comes with. I am 74 years old and this issue is causing me mental stress and anxiety to my health.

I am also confused to why Clear Creek Baptist School would choose to have this tower put on their property, considering they have students living in the schools housing units that will be extremely close to this tower. These individuals will also be exposed to the strobing lights from this tower. I have spoken to other residents in this community and like myself are highly against the building of this cell tower. The building of this tower is invading our privacy.

I am asking for the Public Service Commission to do their duty and represent the citizens of this community and speak out on behalf of the individuals that will be affected by the building of this tower. I am enclosing a copy of the map that was included in the letter I received from Pike Legal showing the location of the tower they intend to build. I am encircling the locations of my residence and location of

the cabin I propose to build. I am also sending a copy of this letter to the President of Clear Creak College as well as to Congressman Hal Rogers.
