**Notice of Proposed Construction of
Wireless Communications Facility
Site Name: Mt. Olivet**

Cellco Partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless and Horvath Communications propose to construct a wireless communications facility on a site located at +/- 719 Kentontown Rd; Mt. Olivet KY 41064 (North Latitude: 38° 31' 50.30", West Longitude: 84° 02' 58.79"). The proposed facility will include a 295-foot-tall, guyed, tower, plus a 10-foot lightning arrestor and related ground facilities. This facility is needed to provide improved coverage for wireless communications in the area.

This notice is being sent to you because the County Property Valuation Administrator's records indicate that you may own property that is within a 500' radius of the proposed tower site or contiguous property on which the tower is to be constructed. You have a right to submit testimony to the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC"), either in writing or to request intervention in the PSC's proceedings on the application. You may contact PSC for additional information concerning this matter at: Kentucky Public Service Commission, Executive Director, 211 Sower Boulevard, PO Box 615, Frankfort Kentucky 40602. Please refer to docket number 2026-00054 in any correspondence sent in connection with this matter.

We have attached a map showing the site location for the proposed tower. Co-Applicant's radio frequency engineers assisted in selecting the proposed site for the facility, and they have determined it is the proper location and elevation needed to provide quality service to wireless customers in the area. We received your letter with the notice of the proposed construction of a wireless communications facility in our County. The docket number is 2026-00054.

After reviewing this letter we have concerns that we would like addressed. They are as follows:

1. Will the tower's height affect the aesthetic beauty of our county/town?
2. Can the tower be shorter?
3. Will the bulldozing and/or construction affect streams?
4. Will the wireless communications affect ham radio communications?

5. Will the wireless communications or the guyed tower affect either helicopter traffic/communications or our emergency medical communications?
6. We sometimes have a need for a helicopter landing at our fire hall, which is close to the proposed site. Will this tower affect these landings?
7. Will the guyed telecommunications tower and associated equipment affect migratory birds?
8. Will there be light emissions or light interference with this tower?
9. What kind of energy emissions will occur with the tower and its wireless communications? Are these emissions dangerous?
10. Are there any type of emissions that can have short- or long-term health effects emanating from this tower or its wireless telecommunications?
