**Subject:** Public Comment — Opposition to Muskie Data Campus Energy Demands

To the Kentucky Public Service Commission,

I am writing as a resident of Floyd County, Kentucky to formally oppose the energy infrastructure demands of the proposed "Muskie Data Campus" at EastPark Industrial Park near Grayson and Ashland, KY.

This facility is projected to consume up to 1 gigawatt of continuous power by 2030 — enough electricity to power hundreds of thousands of homes. I am deeply concerned that accommodating this demand will require Kentucky Power/AEP to construct additional gas or coal generating plants, the costs of which will be passed directly to everyday

ratepayers across our region in the form of higher monthly electric bills.

I urge the PSC to:

- Require a full ratepayer impact study before approving any grid expansion connected to this project
- Ensure that the cost burden of new infrastructure falls on the data center developer, not local residents
- Hold public hearings accessible to Boyd, Carter, and Floyd County residents before any decisions are made
