*We have been given no exact information about whether or not our electric rates will be changing.

*We have been given no information about how this facility might affect our children, our veterans, or our livestock. (See national news stories about stillborn calves in TX)-our only reference.

Not releasing any information about these issues just says that someone is hiding something. Our county government won't talk about anything related to this, they are shifting responsibility to the local energy and water facilities to answer any questions. They apparently won't.

By denying this application, you would join many lawmakers statewide and in Washington who are responding to their constituents and banning these facilities. Please help your community members with this issue.
