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As a residential customer of Kentucky Power residing in Boyd County, I am writing to submit a formal public comment regarding the utility's resource planning, large industrial interconnections, and the proposed 1-gigawatt TeraWulf data center campus at EastPark.

Given the Commission's active investigation under Case No. 2026-00159 into Kentucky Power's troubling planning practices and its failure to provide thorough analysis when making massive financial choices, the public cannot trust the utility to self-regulate a connection of this unprecedented scale. A massive 1-gigawatt draw risks severely straining our regional grid capacity and exposing everyday families in Eastern Kentucky to surging utility bills via Fuel Adjustment Clauses when expensive emergency replacement power must be purchased.

****I strongly urge the Commission to prevent Kentucky Power from quietly processing this massive data center under generic, outdated large-industrial tariffs. I request that the PSC mandate a dedicated, highly scrutinized Data Center Tariff for this project—similar to safeguards implemented for other Commonwealth utilities—ensuring strict corporate accountability and ironclad ratepayer protections before any infrastructure or power supply**

agreements are finalized.
