ORDER

A hearing in the above-styled matter was held on Wednesday, July 8, 2026. At the opening of the hearing the Commission found that there was good cause to grant Kentucky Power Company's (Kentucky Power) July 6, 2026 motion for deviation from the notice requirement of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(b). At the conclusion of the witness testimony, a procedural schedule was established that provided for post-hearing requests for information and briefing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Kentucky Power's July 6, 2026 motion for deviation seeking relief from portions of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(b) is granted.
2. Post-hearing requests for information, if any, shall be filed on or before July 14, 2026.
3. Responses to post-hearing requests for information shall be filed on or before July 28, 2026.

4. Counsel for Kentucky Power and intervenors shall file memorandum briefs, if any, in support of their post-hearing positions on or before August 21, 2026.

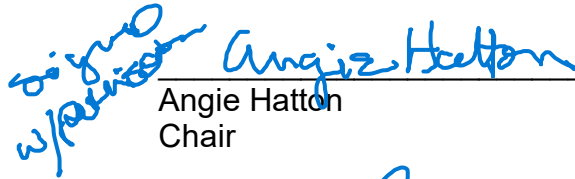
5. Counsel for Kentucky Power and intervenors may submit reply briefs responding to another party's post hearing brief on or before August 28, 2026.

6. This case shall stand submitted for a decision by the Commission effective 12:01 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time, on August 29, 2026.

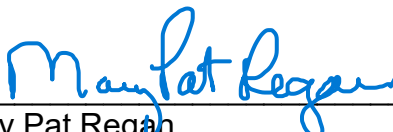

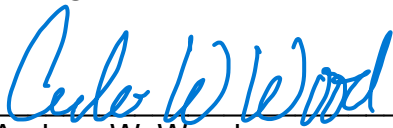
