ORDER

On June 24, 2026, the Commission entered a final Order in this matter. The Order inadvertently approved a surcharge of \$0.6024 per Mcf effective July 1, 2026, rather than an *increased* surcharge of \$0.6024 per Mcf. Finding that the June 24, 2026 Order shall be amended, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS, *nunc pro tunc*, that:

1. The sentence on page 12 of the June 24, 2026 Order that states

In response to Staff's Second Request, Apache reevaluated its projected cash flow needs and determined that a temporary surcharge of \$0.6024 per Mcf starting July 1, 2026 is necessary for the balance of calendar year 2026.

is stricken and replaced with the following language:

In response to Staff's Second Request, Apache reevaluated its projected cash flow needs and determined that a temporary surcharge **increase** of \$0.6024 per Mcf starting July 1, 2026 is necessary for the balance of calendar year 2026.

2. The sentence on page 13 of the June 24, 2026 Order that states

Having considered the record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission approves the temporary volumetric surcharge of \$0.6024 per Mcf for the remainder of calendar

year 2026 to ensure that Apache can meet its finalized debt obligations.

is stricken and replaced with the following language:

Having considered the record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission approves the **increased** temporary volumetric surcharge of \$0.6024 per Mcf for the remainder of calendar year 2026 to ensure that Apache can meet its finalized debt obligations. **This would bring the surcharge total per Mcf to \$0.8924.**

3. Ordering paragraph 2 of the June 24, 2026 Order that states

Apache is authorized to implement a PRP surcharge of \$0.6024 per Mcf effective July 1, 2026. The surcharge shall be reviewed in Apache's next annual PRP filing in 2027, at which time the Commission will determine the appropriate PRP surcharge rate based on the utility's updated revenue requirements, debt service obligations, and actual surcharge collections.

is stricken and replaced with the following language:

Apache is authorized to implement an **increased** PRP surcharge of \$0.6024 per Mcf, **for a total of \$0.8924 per Mcf**, effective July 1, 2026. The surcharge shall be reviewed in Apache's next annual PRP filing in 2027, at which time the Commission will determine the appropriate PRP surcharge rate based on the utility's updated revenue requirements, debt service obligations, and actual surcharge collections.

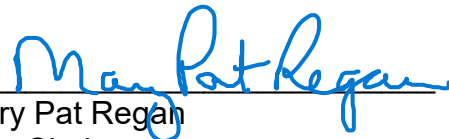
4. All other provisions of the Commission's June 24, 2026 Order that are not in conflict with the terms of this Order shall remain in effect.
