COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION  
TO KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY AND SHELBY ENERGY COOPERATIVE, INC.

Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) and Shelby Energy Cooperative, Inc. (Shelby Energy), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on June 18, 2026. The Commission directs KU and Shelby Energy to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085<sup>1</sup> regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the

person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

KU and Shelby Energy shall make timely amendment to any prior response if KU and Shelby Energy obtain information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which KU and Shelby Energy fail or refuse to furnish all or part of the requested information, KU and Shelby Energy shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, KU and Shelby Energy shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Refer to Case No. 2014-00224,<sup>2</sup> final Order, Appendix B. At the time of filing the application in this case, indicate whether KU or Shelby Energy was aware of the previously approved changes to the boundary in Case No. 2014-00224.

2. Provide a new site map for Rolling Ridge that has the corrected boundary which was approved in Case No. 2014-00224. Ensure the new site map has updated coordinates, signatures, and dates.

3. Explain why KU is requesting boundary changes nearly identical to those approved twelve years ago in Case No. 2014-00224.<sup>3</sup>

4. Explain whether KU or Shelby Energy have been providing electric services for the area at issue in this application immediately prior to and after the final Order issued in Case No. 2014-00224.

5. Provide any relevant context/information regarding the area where changes to the boundary are proposed in the Rolling Ridge site map.

6. Provide an updated quadrant map that shows all historical changes to boundary lines, including the proposed changes in this case. Case numbers to include Case No. 2014-00224,<sup>4</sup> Case No. 2022-00287,<sup>5</sup> Case No. 2023-00201,<sup>6</sup> Case No. 2026-00085 (current). Include some way to identify the corresponding Commission approval. Ensure the new quadrant map has updated coordinates, signatures, and dates.
