IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:





### APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 2026-00097 DATED APR 30 2026

#### AGENDA

The following topics are to be discussed at the informal conference in this proceeding.

1. Discussion of Applicable Statutes. Joint Applicants to explain whether they are seeking approval under KRS 278.020(7). If so, Joint Applicants to explain why the transfer of control is being made in accordance with law, for a proper purpose and is consistent with the public interest. If not, Joint Applicants to explain why they are exempt.
2. Discussion of Statutory Dates. Joint Applicants requested an Order from the Commission approving their transaction no later than 60 days from the date of filing of this Joint Application pursuant to KRS 278.020(6). However, KRS 278.020(6) contains no 60-day statutory deadline.
3. Contracts. Joint Applicants to discuss the contracts listed in Schedule 3.8 and whether Kentucky-American plans to enter into contracts with Black Mountain District's existing suppliers.
4. Indebtedness. Joint Applicants to confirm that Kentucky-American will not be assuming any of Black Mountain District's indebtedness.
5. Tariff and Rate Changes. Joint Applicants to discuss the impact of the transfer of control on Black Mountain District's services and rates. Joint Applicants to discuss the applicability of 807 KAR 5:011.

6. Black Mountain District wastewater customers. Black Mountain District to discuss how wastewater customers will continue to be served and whether approval of the transfer of control would have any rate impacts on those customers.

7. Schedules. Joint Applicants to provide updates on when the schedules that should accompany the Agreement for Purchase of Black Mountain Utility District system will be filed.
