COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO KENTUCKY FRONTIER GAS, LLC

Kentucky Frontier Gas, LLC (Kentucky Frontier), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on June 8, 2026. The Commission directs Kentucky Frontier to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the

response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Kentucky Frontier shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Kentucky Frontier obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Kentucky Frontier fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Kentucky Frontier shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Kentucky Frontier shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Refer to Kentucky Frontier's Gas Cost Recovery (GCR) rate report filing. Provide Schedules I, II, and IV in an Excel spreadsheet format with all formulas, columns, and rows unprotected and fully accessible.

2. Refer to Kentucky Frontier's GCR rate report filing, Schedule II, the Expected Gas Cost (EGC) calculation. Provide the invoices for the following suppliers: Nytis; Slone Energy; and Tackett. To the extent the invoices do not correspond to the

Mcf purchases for the 12 months ended March 31, 2026, provide the meter readings and the rate for the months not represented in the invoices.

3. Refer to Kentucky Frontier's GCR rate report filing, Schedule II, the EGC calculation. Also, refer to the invoices provided for Interstate Natural Gas Company, LLC (ING). Provide the meter readings and rate paid for the months of January, February, and March 2026.

4. Refer to Kentucky Frontier's GCR rate report filing, Schedule II, the EGC calculation. Also, refer to the invoices provided for Sonny Hall Wells Partner (Sonny Hall). Provide the meter readings and rate paid for the months of December 2025 and January, February, and March 2026.

5. Refer to Kentucky Frontier's GCR rate report filing, Schedule II, the EGC calculation. Also, refer to the invoices provided for KLC Enterprises, LLC (KLC).

a. It appears the invoice for the month of August 2025 was inadvertently omitted. Provide the missing August 2025 invoice, if unable to provide explain.

b. Provide the calculation for the total Mcf purchased and total cost in an Excel spreadsheet format with all formulas, columns, and rows unprotected and fully accessible.

6. Refer to Kentucky Frontier's GCR rate report filing, Schedule II, the EGC calculation. Provide the existing contracts for the suppliers listed. In the event that Kentucky Frontier is unable to locate the existing contract, explain why and provide justification for the rate as it appears on Schedule II. If the contracts are in the case record of another case, provide the case number under which they were filed and a citation where they can be located.

7. Confirm that the \$3.60 per Mcf in the Kentucky Frontier's current Farm Tap Tariff is a weighted average cost of gas. Explain how Kentucky Frontier originally arrived at \$3.60 per Mcf.
