COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO DELTA NATURAL GAS COMPANY, INC.

Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. (Delta), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on June 4, 2026. The Commission directs Delta to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the

response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Delta shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Delta obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Delta fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Delta shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Delta shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Refer to the Application, page 2.
 - a. Provide the name and number of customers that are served at the Lincoln County Industrial Park through Delta's last economic development extension (EDX), an estimate of their collective annual usage, and the date they started taking service.

b. Provide a timeline for Delta's last EDX, from approval in Case No. 2020-00406² to the first customer to take service.

2. Refer to the Application, pages 2–3 and Exhibit 3.

a. Explain whether Delta will receive any outside funds or grants for this project.

b. Provide any deadlines for outside funding or grant applications or requests.

c. Confirm that any funding received from the Menifee, Morgan & Rowan County (MMRC) Regional Industrial Development Authority, the Morehead Rowan County Industrial Development Authority, or the Morehead-Rowan County Chamber of Commerce will be recorded as contributions in aid of construction. If this cannot be confirmed, explain.

d. Explain whether there are other entities that may provide outside funding or grants for this project. If so, provide the entity and the potential amount of funding.

3. Refer to the Application, pages 3–4. Provide a breakdown of the estimated \$4.9 million cost for project engineering, right-of-way acquisition, tap, and purchase station.

4. Provide a description of the proposed site and the anticipated customer(s) or customer type(s). Include in the response whether natural gas is an essential requirement for the operations of the customer(s).

5. Explain whether Delta anticipates filing a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) for this project. If not, explain. If so, state when Delta expects to request a CPCN.

6. Provide the estimated timeline for the project, including when easements will be acquired and when Delta estimates it will begin construction.
