COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO
KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY AND
BLUE GRASS ENERGY COOPERATIVE CORPORATION

Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) and Blue Grass Energy Cooperative Corporation (Blue Grass Energy) (jointly, Joint Applicants), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on August 24, 2026. The Commission directs Joint Applicants to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a

governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Joint Applicants shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Joint Applicants obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Joint Applicants fail or refuse to furnish all or part of the requested information, Joint Applicants shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Joint Applicants shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. For each parcel:
 - a. Provide the cost for each current utility to service its parcel. Include in the response a breakdown of the cost(s) as well as any estimates or work papers, in

Excel spreadsheet format with all formulas, columns, and rows unprotected and fully accessible.

b. Provide the estimated cost for each utility to serve the proposed service parcel. Include in the response a breakdown of the cost(s), as well as any estimates or workpapers, in Excel spreadsheet format with all formulas, columns, and rows unprotected and fully accessible.

2. Confirm that the homeowner with the self-served solar system will be fully electric receiving service as a residential customer or will an interconnection survey² be conducted. If not confirmed, explain the response.

3. Describe how each parcel is zoned, by parcel, and identify the entity that has the zoning authority.

4. Describe the type of customers or proposed customers for each parcel. Include in the response the corresponding parcel the customer is located as well as the class of service the customer receives or may receive service under.
