COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO EAST KENTUCKY POWER COOPERATIVE, INC.

East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (EKPC), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on August 27, 2026. The Commission directs EKPC to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the

response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

EKPC shall make timely amendment to any prior response if EKPC obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

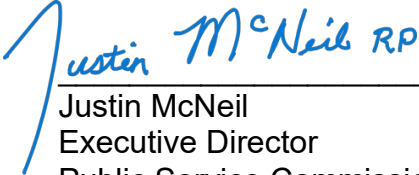
For any request to which EKPC fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, EKPC shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, EKPC shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Refer to the proposed Rate H – Wholesale Renewable Energy Program, P.S.C. No. 35 (Rate H tariff), Third Revised Sheet No. 38. Refer also to the letter to the PSC Executive Director (Letter). The Letter states that EKPC proposes to remove the avoided costs of fuel and variable environmental surcharge from the credit calculation. However, the proposed Rate H tariff appears to not revise the language to exclude the

environmental surcharge and Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) credits from the customer credit calculation.

- a. Clarify that the total credit will always equal the PJM Interconnection LLC (PJM) Locational Marginal Price (LMP).
 - b. Explain and reconcile the language discrepancy.
2. Refer to the Letter. Provide an estimate of the cost to upgrade the billing software. Include in the response any supporting documentation to the estimate.
 3. Provide a detailed table that explains how many customers currently take service under each option of Rate H from each of EKPC's customer classes.
 4. Identify and provide all agreements under Rate H Option B.
 5. Explain whether EKPC has provided credits to existing Rate H Option B customers.
 6. Refer to the Letter. Explain how using PJM's LMP is more effective than the already approved alternative credit calculation.
