I was told that the meter was faulty and I had not been being charged for usage for previous months. I took them at their word.

They installed a new meter. Because of their faulty meter they agreed to a 12 month interest free payment plan on the \$3678.62 amount. They never informed me that they put this on autopay. When I went online to setup autopay it kicked the entire amount onto the next bill (\$4176.10). This was taken out of my account on 2/2/26. I made numerous calls and emails

to the president (John Crockett)  
and Customer Relations and  
they would not honor  
our agreement caused by  
their faulty equipment.  
They don't even reply to  
my calls and emails 2  
now.

Hi Mike!

The easiest, and quickest, way for you to re-enroll in Auto Pay is through your online account. This is a two-step process: first, you will need to add the new bank information and then, you will need to enroll in the Auto Pay program. Please be sure to delete your old bank information to prevent accidentally selecting that account in the future for payments.

Once you have logged into your online account, please follow the below steps to register your bank information:

- Select the "Profile" tab on the right-hand side towards the top
- Select "Manage banks" under Profile Overview and click the red garbage can to remove any unwanted banks
- Click the link that says "Add new bank"
- Complete the remaining steps to fully add the bank information. Please be sure that the Account Owner section matches exactly the name that is printed on your check

Once you have registered the bank information, you will then need to enroll in the Auto Pay program. Please follow the below steps to enroll in the Auto Pay program:

- Select "Payment Programs" on the left-hand side
- Select "Auto Pay"
- Click the gray "Enroll in Auto Pay" button
- Complete the remaining steps to fully enroll in the Auto Pay program

Enrollment takes effect within the hour!

I also want to remind you that your current bill of \$833.91 is due on 1/14. This bill includes a payment for the paymnet arrangement, so payment will need to be made by 7pm ET on the due to avoid the arrangement defaulting. Keep in mind that Auto Pay goes into effect immediately, so there will be no need to make additional payments once you are enrolled.
