7. Following his presentation to the Association's Board of Director's in May 2026, Mr. Hemphill filed two civil actions in Pulaski County Circuit Court naming South Eastern Water and other parties as Defendants. Essentially he is claiming title to certain parcels of real property that share a common grantor with his family farm. The severance of these parcels from a common grantor dates to 1976 40 YR misleading type 0. 1936. The land upon which the Association's Blue John Water Storage Tank sits is one such parcel. 12 days after BOARD Meeting pleading to negotiate in good faith. ANOTHER RELEVANT OMISSION FALSE

8. The Commission approved the construction of the Blue John Tank and the water line extension, which serves Mr. Hemphill's property, in 2006 in Case No. 2006-00371.² The project was funded by the federal government acting through the Department of Agriculture, office of Rural Development ("RD") and by customer connections to the line extension.³ There were over 150 potential new customers in the area where Mr. Hemphill's farm is located when the Blue John Tank and water line extension was proposed.⁴ LEFT FARMER Family 1976 to JAMES (PNC) GRACIE (FARMER) Calhoun is LUTHER's daughter → REBEAU → HURST HILL RD.
