Complaint C-The specific acts, reasons and basis for complaint.

1. Failure to operate for a true mutual benefit KRS.273.233.
2. Systemic fiduciary failure, gross corporate negligence and misconduct.
3. Executive intimidation and bad faith retaliation by general manager Morris Vaughn KSR 273.233 and 382.270.
4. Double dip tariff cost to legacy member with 2 existing meters on the same family farm.
5. Deceptive concealment of farm exemptions.
6. Stealth retaliatory instillation of meter to activate computer generated bill. This was done one year early, without notice of being installed.
7. Record suppression, systematic double billing fraud KRS 278.160 and 278.170.
8. *Possible* Falsification of records for holding clear title to .91 acre footprint of daily trespass on Hemphill family farm to the US Department of Agriculture and the IRS to secure funding and permits.
9. Confession of scale SEW states 709 meters per tower collecting a minimum of \$32.00 bill each. This equates to \$22,688 a month, \$272,256 annually, \$5,445,120 over 20 years of unjust enrichment on just one tower.
10. Southeast Water completely skipped a title search all together to buy a wild deed for \$2500.00. This land has been protected by federally shielded corners since 1935 with USDA installed monument corners in place.

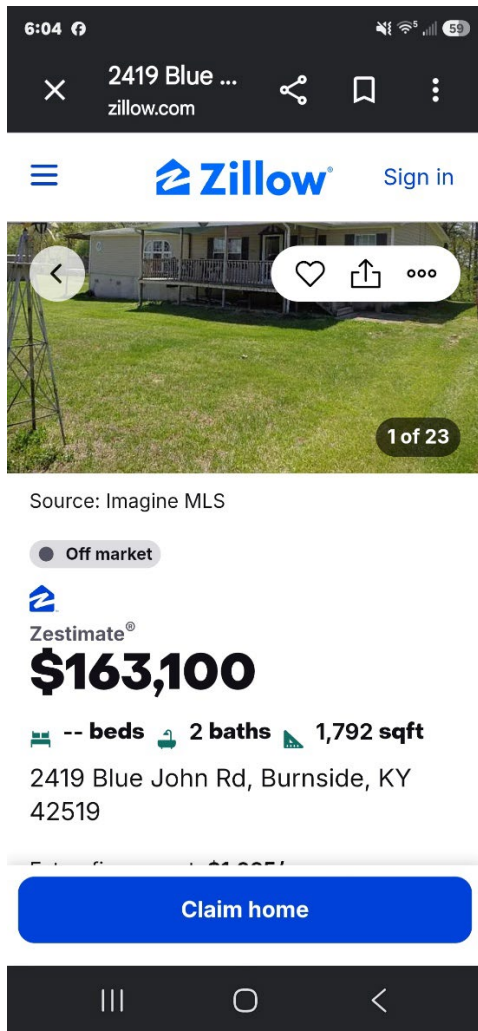

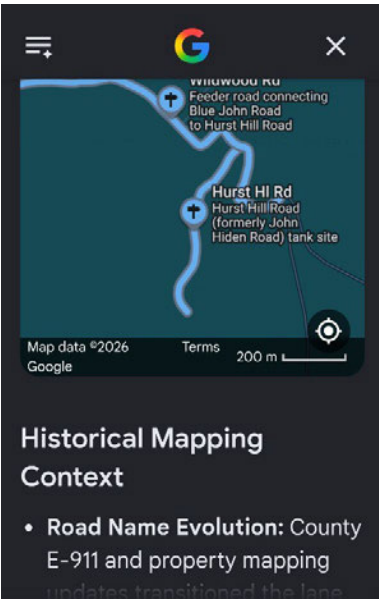
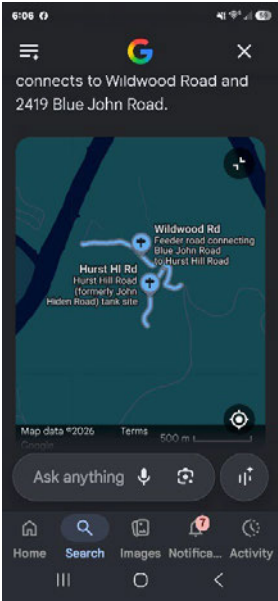
