ORDER

On July 31, 2026, Atmos Energy Corporation (Atmos) filed an application to set Pipeline Modernization (PM) Rider rates. The application proposed that the new rates become effective on October 1, 2026. Also on July 31, 2026, Atmos also filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) for its first proposed PM projects.¹

The Commission finds that since the initial PM CPCN will not have been fully examined by Commission Staff by the effective date, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), the Commission will suspend the effective date of the proposed rates for one day, up to and including October 2, 2026. After that date, and upon notice in compliance with KRS 278.190(2), Atmos may put proposed rates into effect, subject to refund.

If Atmos places its proposed rates into effect subject to refund prior to a final Order being issued in this matter, Atmos should maintain its records in a manner as will enable it, or the commission, or any of its customers, to determine the amounts to be refunded and to whom due in the event a refund is ordered.

The Commission also finds that a procedural schedule should be adopted for this case, as set forth in Appendix A, and will be amended as necessary if intervenors are joined.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Atmos's proposed PM rates are suspended for one day, to October 2, 2026.
2. Atmos's proposed PM rates may be placed in effect by Atmos on or after October 2, 2026, pending the final Order in this matter and subject to refund, provided Atmos provides written notice to the Commission of its intention to do so as required by KRS 278.190(2).
3. If Atmos places proposed rates into effect subject to refund prior to a final Order being issued in this matter, Atmos shall maintain its records in a manner as will enable it, or the commission, or any of its customers, to determine the amounts to be refunded and to whom due in the event a refund is ordered.
4. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall be followed.
5. Atmos shall respond to all requests for information propounded by Commission Staff, whether identified on a procedural schedule or otherwise, as provided in those requests.
6. Any party filing a paper with the Commission shall file an electronic copy in accordance with the electronic filing procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked. The Commission directs the parties to the

Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085² regarding filings with the Commission.

7. As set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(11), a person requesting permissive intervention in a Commission proceeding is required to demonstrate either (1) a special interest in the proceeding that is not otherwise adequately represented in the case, or (2) that intervention is likely to present issues or develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings. Therefore, any person requesting to intervene in a Commission proceeding must state with specificity the person's special interest that is not otherwise adequately represented, or the issues and facts that the person will present that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter. A mere recitation of the quantity of the utility service consumed by the movant or a general statement regarding a potential impact of possible modification of rates will not be deemed sufficient to establish a special interest.

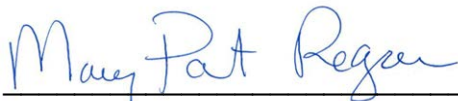
8. Any motion to intervene filed after the date established in the procedural schedule shall also show good cause for being untimely. If the untimely motion is granted, the movant shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule.

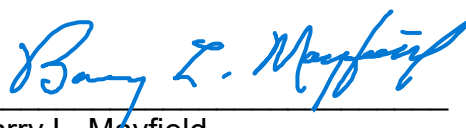
