ORDER

This matter is opened to address a request for deviation from 807 KAR 5:011, Section 11(6)(a)(2) filed by Atmos Energy Corporation (Atmos) via the electronic tariff filing system concurrently with the tariff filed in TFS2026-00408, filed August 14, 2026. Atmos's tariff filing was an adoption notice for its acquisition of Millennium Energy, Inc. (Millennium) in Case No. 2026-00061.¹ Attached to the tariff filing, Atmos provided a customer notice that was sent to the former Millennium customers notifying them that they would be transitioned to the Atmos tariff effective October 1, 2026.² Atmos requested a deviation from 807 KAR 5:011, Section 11(6)(a)(2), which requires the acquiring utility to reissue its complete tariff that establishes the rate and requirements the acquiring utility proposes to place into effect for the customers served by the acquired utility.³ Atmos explained that the only information that would change in its tariff as a result of the acquisition would be the revision number, the issuance date, and the effective date and

that reissuance of its entire tariff would not serve any purpose to further educate the former Millennium customers.⁴

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011, Section 15, the Commission shall permit deviations from tariff regulations for good cause shown. The Commission agrees that reissuing the entire tariff in this instance would not be necessary as no substantive changes would be made. Therefore, the Commission finds good cause to grant Atmos's request for a deviation from 807 KAR 5:011, Section 11(6)(a)(2).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Atmos's request for a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 11(6)(a)(2) with regards to its adoption notice filed on August 14, 2026, in electronic tariff filing system case TFS2026-00408 is granted.

2. This matter is removed from the Commission's docket.

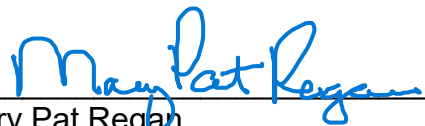

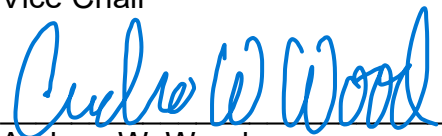

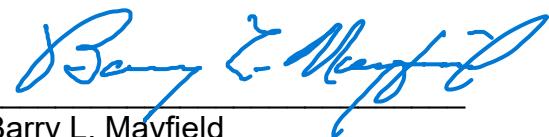
