AGREEMENT FOR TRANSFER OF OPERATION AND RESPONSIBILITY

OF THE BUTLER WATER FILL STATION

This Agreement is entered into on this 2nd day of March, 2026, by and between:

The City of Butler, Kentucky ("City"), a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and
Pendleton County Water District ("PCWD"), a public water utility operating within Pendleton County, Kentucky.

The City and PCWD may be referred to collectively as the "Parties."

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Agreement is to formally transfer operational control and responsibility of the **Butler Water Fill Station** ("Fill Station") from the City to PCWD, including all associated utilities, maintenance, and operational costs. This Agreement also establishes a monthly discount to be applied to the City's water usage.

2. Transfer of Fill Station

- The City hereby **relinquishes all operational control, management duties, and day-to-day responsibilities** of the Butler Water Fill Station to PCWD.
- PCWD agrees to **assume full responsibility** for the operation, maintenance, repair, and oversight of the Fill Station.
- Ownership of the physical property and land on which the Fill Station is located shall remain with the City

3. Utilities and Operating Costs

- Effective on the date of this Agreement, PCWD shall assume responsibility for all **utilities**, including but not limited to:
 - Electric service
 - Maintenance and repair costs
 - Any other operational expenses associated with the Fill Station
- The City shall no longer be billed for any utilities or operational costs related to the Fill Station.

4. Monthly Water Usage Discount for the City

- In consideration of the transfer of the Fill Station, PCWD agrees to provide the City with a **monthly discount** on its municipal water usage.
- This discount shall remain in effect for the duration of this Agreement unless modified by mutual written consent.

5. Liability and Indemnification

- PCWD shall assume all liability arising from the operation and maintenance of the Fill Station after the effective date of this Agreement.
- The City shall not be held responsible for any claims, damages, or liabilities arising from PCWD's operation of the Fill Station.
- PCWD agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City from any such claims.
