## Kentucky Power Company Summary of Demand Side Management Expenses Month Ended: April 2016

April expenditures of \$230,354.32 are below the budgeted amount of \$436,098 with a negative variance of \$205,744. Commercial program expenditures were \$85,489 below budget and residential program expenditures were \$120,255 below budget. Year-to-date, 2016 DSM/EE expenditures are \$552,607 below the budgeted amount. Commercial program expenditures are \$253,242 below budget and residential program expenditures are \$299,364 below budget.

Two new commercial programs, Express Install and Retro-Commissioning, are in start-up mode. Together, these two programs account for a \$199,324 shortfall in the YTD commercial program budget. Both programs are anticipated to have full participation by the end of the year. Potential customer projects have already been identified for the Retro-Commissioning program and are anticipated to begin during the 2nd half of 2016. Customer projects are expected to begin in June for the Express Install program following the program launch.

The Commercial Incentive Prescriptive Custom program (CIPC) was below budget for April due to a pending invoice totaling \$60,000 that was not submitted by the program implementation contractor in April. The invoice has since been processed and will reflect in the expense month of May.

The Whole House Efficiency program is behind the YTD target. However, the program has issued customer incentives that will move the YTD budget above target. Through April, the program has completed 43% of the targeted home energy audits, and 41% of the targeted HVAC upgrades.

The Targeted Energy Efficiency weatherization program is behind YTD targets primarily because of agencies utilizing available LIHEAP funds through the Weatherization Assistance Program. The future trend for home audits and weatherization services is positive as the Community Action agencies begin to increase audits and weatherization services provided through the DSM program. Expanding the program in the coming months to include support for efficient windows and doors will increase the program investment.
