Dear Mr. Schuchter:

This is in response to your request for the rehabilitation of an existing municipal water intake structure located along the Ohio River at River Mile 463.68 near Fort Thomas in Campbell County, Kentucky. The proposed work consists of cleaning and repairing exterior foundation walls, replacing mechanical devices related to the intake of the water from the Ohio River, replacing a section of structural flooring, repairing interior access platforms, repairing exterior masonry, cleaning and rehabilitating intact windows and replacing broken windows. In order to facilitate the repairs, you propose to install a sump pump below ordinary high water to remove accumulated sediment and maintain water level low enough to complete the work. The information supplied by you was reviewed to determine whether a Department of the Army (DA) permit will be required under the provisions of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.

Your project is considered maintenance of a structure which has been previously authorized, either by DA Permit or by having been constructed prior to current Federal laws. Therefore, the project is authorized under the provisions of 33 CFR 330 Nationwide Permit (NWP) No. 3, <u>Maintenance</u>, as published in the Federal Register February 21, 2012. Under the provisions of this authorization, you must comply with the enclosed Terms and General Conditions for Nationwide Permit No. 3 and the following Special Conditions:

- The permittee shall adhere to the following conditions of the Kentucky State Historic Preservation Officer:
 - a. Removing vegetation from the building using the gentlest method possible so no additional damage is done on the historic masonry. Please refer to: <u>https://www.gsa.gov/portal/content/111782;</u>
 - b. For historic bricks or stone blocks too damaged to retain, replacing in kind with bricks or stone blocks of matching size, color, and finish;
 - c. Re-pointing with period-correct lime mortar; and

d. For windows too damaged to retain, replacing in kind with painted wooden windows with the same light pattern, dimensions, and profiles as existing windows. Please consider matching not just the windows themselves but the depth they are recessed from the wall plate. Missing transoms which need to be replaced should be replaced in kind with wooden transoms to match the existing historic, two-light transoms.

You must also comply with the enclosed Water Quality Certification (WQC) Conditions for Nationwide Permit No. 3 dated March 19, 2012, issued by the Kentucky Division of Water (KDOW). Once you obtain your certification, or if no application was required, you may proceed with the project without further contact or verification from us.

This verification is valid until the NWP is modified, reissued, or revoked. All of the existing NWPs are scheduled to be modified, reissued, or revoked prior to March 18, 2017. It is incumbent upon you to remain informed of changes to the NWPs. We will issue a public notice when the NWPs are reissued. Furthermore, if you commence or are under contract to commence this activity before the date that the relevant nationwide permit is modified or revoked, you will have twelve (12) months from the date of the modification or revocation of the NWP to complete the activity under the present terms and conditions of this nationwide permit. The enclosed Compliance Certification should be⁶ signed and returned when the project is completed. Please note that we also perform periodic inspections to ensure compliance with our permit conditions and applicable Federal laws. A copy of this letter is being sent to the appropriate coordinating agencies and to your agent (see enclosure for addresses).
