

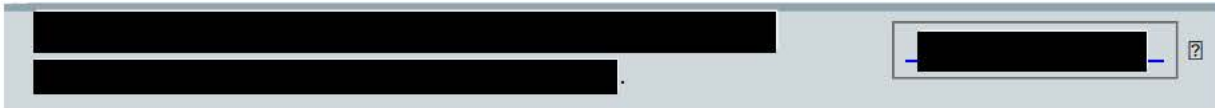

If it is not too late to do so, I respectfully ask that the following be added to my previous public comment regarding Henderson County Solar LLC/Stellar Renewable Power LLC, Case #2020-00391.

I submitted my earlier written public comment February 16, 2026, to express concern that the proposed solar development will amplify a new source of noise that will pass directly over the proposed site and further into rural areas.

Very recently, an article regarding this noise and the impact on some local residents (myself included) was published in The Hendersonian. After the article was posted to social media on Facebook, additional property owners posted and confirmed the level of noise. I also had another reach out to me privately to express how it has affected their lives. Even though there have been multiple local officials who have publicly tried to dismiss and discredit my contention regarding the detrimental level of noise, these personal accounts bolster the evidence that the noise is a public concern.

I am including a link to Dropbox below to a video demonstrating the magnitude of the noise. Please note that this is a recording when the decibel level was at

55 dBA, which is five decibels below the highest I've noted in the logs I keep. The only effective and accurate way to listen is to listen to it at that level. If there is not a dedicated decibel reader available, there are free apps that are very accurate; I recommend Decibel X. Make sure the weight is set to A (not B or C) and ensure the device used to read the decibel level is close to you so it can measure the appropriate level depending on the distance to the device playing the video.

I would also note that it is worth pointing out that every recording device, whether it is a phone or not, is made to enhance sounds closest and minimize noise from further away. This explains why at a 55 dBA level, an opening door or bird calls sound extraordinarily loud. It is the background noise that is important in this recording. At the proper listening level, the noise should be clearly audible before the door is even opened. There are times that the facility is quiet, perhaps for maintenance, and the level of noise may otherwise fluctuate and lessen. However, the greatest majority of time there is noticeable and obvious noise.

In addition, in the letter we received from Stellar Renewable Power dated December 16, 2025, it was clearly stated that ambient noise levels are expected to return to current or lower levels after construction is complete. If the noise is amplified instead, what will be Stellar's responsibility in honoring what they claim?

I realize that my concerns may not even be addressed in the outcome for this matter, but to be honest, I sincerely feel that I have to do everything I can to bring attention to the issue before it is, indeed, an issue. I am not trying to be an obstructionist, and I am not attempting to stop development. I am simply a property owner with valid concerns trying to not only find solutions but also address something that not only affects me but my fellow property owners as well.
