### **Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting Evidentiary Hearing – Case No. 2020-00391 March 26, 2026**

Good morning, Chairman and members of the Siting Board.

My name is Shannon Hill. I live in Henderson County, and I am speaking today on behalf of hundreds of families in District 4 and across our county who are fighting to protect our homes, our land, and our way of life.

We are here with one clear demand: **revoke** the conditional construction certificate for the Henderson County Solar project immediately. Stellar Renewable Power has lost the right to build.

Your own Order on January 30, 2026 already declared that this company must show cause why its certificate should not be revoked. Today, the evidence is overwhelming. They have **twice** violated the very heart of your conditions — Mitigation Measure 26 — and they have done so deliberately.

Measure 26 is not optional. It is crystal clear. It states that **any** transfer of ownership or control

**must** receive **explicit prior approval** from this Board, with notice to the Henderson County Fiscal Court.

They ignored it — not once, but twice.

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Because this certificate was **expressly conditional** on full compliance with every mitigation measure, these violations render it invalid. The project should have been stopped the first time they broke the rules.

Five long years of silence followed — no construction, no final site plan, no updates — while our county passed a solar moratorium in February 2025 to protect us from exactly these risks. Now, without warning, Stellar suddenly announces construction could begin any day.

We have already watched this same story play out in Robards: gunfire shattering panels, inverters catching fire, glare blinding drivers, flooding ruining fields, and property values crashing. Those are not distant warnings — those are our neighbors' lived reality.

Chairman, this Board exists to protect Kentucky families, not to rubber-stamp corporate shortcuts. When a company twice ignores your explicit conditions, hides transfers for months, and then demands to break ground without accountability, the only responsible action is revocation.

We therefore urge you — **revoke this conditional construction certificate today**. Force Stellar to start over with a new application, a full public hearing, and real compliance with current law and Henderson County's protections.

Our community has waited long enough. Our families deserve better. Do not let this project move forward on broken rules.

### **NOTICE TO NEARBY RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES: HENDERSON COUNTY SOLAR**

Stellar Renewable Power is preparing to begin construction of Henderson County Solar, located just outside the city limits of the City of Henderson. Construction is anticipated to begin in January and continue through the first quarter of 2027. You are receiving this letter because your property at the address above is within 2,400 feet of the project boundary.

#### ***Construction Overview***

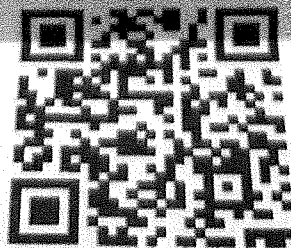
Stellar will limit construction activities and deliveries in accordance with applicable regulations and requirements. In designated portions of the site closest to businesses and residences, certain construction activities will be limited to more restrictive working hours.

Mitigation measures will be implemented to minimize disruption during construction. Pile driving within 1,500 feet of nearby homes will use noise-reducing methods. A traffic management plan will be followed to reduce the impact of the project on local traffic during construction. Best management practices for controlling fugitive dust will be maintained throughout construction to keep dust impacts minimal.

Construction is not expected to noticeably increase existing sound occurring on the site. After construction, ambient noise levels are expected to return to current or lower levels, with residences positioned at least 200 feet from solar panels and 750 feet from inverters.
