If a sufficient demonstration that the records continue to qualify as exempt under KRS 61.878 is not made, the PSC will release the subject materials in response to the request and may take action to make the materials otherwise available for public inspection.

The Public Service Commission (PSC) is complying with your request received October 9, 2025, pursuant to the Kentucky Open Records Act, KRS 61.870 – KRS 61.884. Your request sought:

Please consider this letter to be an Open Records Request for the production of a copy of your full file, including, but not limited to any and all filings, for Case No. 2021-00346.

The linked case file includes items that were identified as responsive to the request but were previously granted confidential treatment¹ pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001 Section 13. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001 Section 13(10)(d), 807 KAR 5:001 Section 13(7), (8), and KRS 61.872(5), the PSC will send notice to the parties that originally requested the items be granted confidential treatment. Those parties will be given 20 days of receipt of the notice to demonstrate that the material still falls within the exclusions from disclosure requirements established in KRS 61.878. If the parties are unable to make the demonstration, the PSC shall make the requested materials available, or if the party is able to make the demonstration, the PSC shall deny the requested inspection.

Accordingly, portions of the requested records are in "active use, in storage or not otherwise

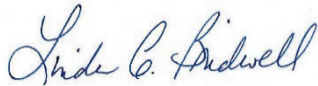

available” as contemplated by KRS 61.872(5). Pursuant to KRS 61.872(5) the earliest date for inspection or copies of the responsive documents will be 3:30 p.m. EST, on November 10, 2025, at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601. A digital copy of the non-confidential responsive records and response will also be sent.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by filing a complaint with the Kentucky Office of the Attorney General, Open Records/Open Meetings Division, The Capitol, 700 Capitol Avenue, Suite 118, Frankfort, KY 40601, pursuant to KRS 61.880(2), or by filing an original civil action in the Franklin Circuit Court under KRS 61.882. If you first appeal to the Attorney General but are dissatisfied with the Attorney General’s decision, you may further appeal to circuit court pursuant to KRS 61.880(5).
