To Whom It May Concern:

On June 11, 2026, the Commission received a request from Mindy Hupp pursuant to the Kentucky Open Records Act, KRS 61.870, et seq., and 807 5:001 Section 13, to inspect materials that Louisville Gas and Electric Company's and Kentucky Utilities Company's (LG&E/KU) filed in Case No. 2021-00346. A copy of the request and the Commission's response to the request are attached to this letter.

In the case reference above, LG&E/KU requested<sup>1</sup> and received confidential protection<sup>2</sup> for a redacted portion of its Response to Commission Staff's Request for Information, Item 14, attachment 1, filed on May 10, 2024.<sup>3</sup>

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(10)d) please accept this letter as LG&E/KU's notification of the request and its options, LG&E/KU has until July 14, 2026, to demonstrate that the material continues to qualify for confidential protection pursuant to KRS 61.878. If a sufficient demonstration that the records continue to qualify as exempt under KRS 61.878 is not made, the PSC will release the subject materials in response to the request and may take action to make the materials otherwise available for public inspection.

If LG&E/KU wishes to file a response it should be made in the Post Case File of Case No. 2023-00361 *Electronic Joint Application of Kentucky Utilities Company and Louisville Gas and Electric Company for a Site Compatibility Certificate for the Construction of a Solar Facility in Mercer County, Kentucky.*

We are reviewing your request. Following a thorough review of the Commission's records, we located the requested redacted documents which can be found at

The redacted information was granted confidential protection by Commission order on August 16, 2024, for a period of five years.<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001 Section 13(10)(d), 807 KAR 5:001 Section 13(10)(e), 807 KAR 5:001 Section 13(7), (8), and KRS 61.872(5), the PSC will send notice to the parties that originally requested the items be granted confidential protection. Those parties will be given 20 days of receipt of the notice to demonstrate that the material still falls within the exclusions from disclosure requirements established in KRS 61.878. After the 20 day period the Commission will review the record and any responses and determine if the material still qualifies for confidential treatment. If the parties that originally filed the material object to its release in their response, but fail to demonstrate that the materials still qualify for confidential treatment the Commission must enter an Order finding that the material no longer qualifies for confidential treatment, then allow the parties that originally sought confidential protection 20 days to seek other legal remedies before the Commission may release the information.

Accordingly, portions of the requested records are in “active use, in storage or not otherwise available” as contemplated by KRS 61.872(5). Pursuant to KRS 61.872(5) the earliest date for inspection or copies of the responsive documents will be 3:30 p.m. EDT, on August 6, 2026 at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601. If records become available prior to that date the Commission will provide those records to you as soon as practicable.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by filing a complaint with the Kentucky Office of the Attorney General, Open Records/Open Meetings Division, 1024 Capital Center Drive, Suite 200, Frankfort, KY 40601, pursuant to KRS 61.880(2), or by filing an original civil action in the Franklin Circuit Court under KRS 61.882. If you first appeal to the Attorney General but are dissatisfied with the Attorney General’s decision, you may further appeal to circuit court pursuant to KRS 61.880(5).
