Dear Public Service Commissioners:

I am writing to follow-up on the Wood Duck Solar Project in Barren County, 2024-00337. The developer submitted a 6-month report which appears to be severely lacking in activity and much has changed in our community since the initial studies and designs were created.

We have added many new housing units in the area. Farmers have added new structures for animals and bees. A couple of new businesses have opened. New sink holes have developed. The Amish community has expanded.

The original maps (though never finalized and never revealed the total number and location of the inverters, etc.) were completed in June 2023. They were never accurate and are even more distorted with the many changes. The studies relating to the karst topography, endangered species, noise and glare were completed several years prior to 2023 and should be updated.

Additionally, the developer has never submitted an updated financial analysis since the County Judge Executive stated in writing the county will not provide an IRB or PILOT financing.

The public and each household has not been provided with maps to identify location of panels, inverters, stations, glare and noise readings, etc.

The PSC should also know that Wood Duck has withdrawn from the PJM Que. Therefore, the interconnectivity reports are null and void and must be re-written, resubmitted and re-reviewed by the local planning and zoning, the public and the commission.

Additionally, the community of Bent Creek Road should be re-canvassed when a new plan and/or company is vetted and secured.

Wood Duck has not applied for any permits from the Army Corp of Engineers and the community is asking for a hearing to address environmental, waterways and flooding concerns.

Additionally, we do not believe the recent batches of "support" letters are authentic. These letters do not contain complete names or addresses and are identical in words, font and design. Many are from out-of-state and my internet searches have failed to find the "signors." I would like to ask the PSC to conduct an investigation into the letters and if fraudulently submitted,

please remove from the correspondence file as this is an "incentive" to Wood Duck as they try to sell the project to another developer.

There is **wide, wide opposition** to this project and it is growing more each day as Barren County is also fighting a data center. We respectfully ask the commission to consider the time delays in the reports, the failure to update the information and the failure to complete the stipulations as imposed by the commission in the final order as a failure to proceed in good-faith and we ask the project be required to update the information.

We continue to object to this development in Barren County, KY and we thank you for your consideration.
