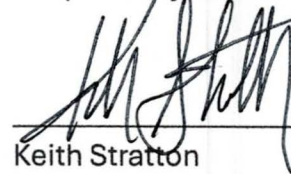

Dear Mr. McNeil:

By Order dated June 3, 2025, in Case No. 2025-00139, the Commission required that Beech Grove file with the Commission on or before July 31, 2026, an application for general rate adjustment pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 16; an application for alternative rate adjustment ("ARF") pursuant to 807 KAR 5:076; or in the alternative, a formal motion with a detailed analysis of its rates and revenues explaining the reasons why no modifications are necessary. As discussed herein, Beech Grove did not meet the requirements of the Commission's Order and now requests additional time to file an ARF.

Beech Grove is a very small system that generally employs a General Manager and an Accounting Clerk. Its operations are directed by a voluntary five-member Board of Directors. On July 27, 2025, the Accounting Clerk contacted Kentucky Rural Water Association's ("KRWA") Water Rate Project Coordinator ("Project Coordinator") to discuss the preparation of rate documents required by the Commission's Order. Following the advice of the Project

Coordinator, the Board of Directors agreed that KRWA would prepare an ARF and cause the ARF to be filed with the Commission based on Beech Grove's 2025 Annual Financial and Statistical Report (Annual Report) after the report became available. However, no formal written contract was entered into at that time.

Beech Grove submitted the Annual Report on or about May 26, 2026. Just prior to the submittal, the Project Coordinator and Accounting Clerk resigned from their positions. Due to KRWA's change in personnel and demanding workload, it was clear that an ARF would not be completed and filed with the Commission prior to July 31, 2026. A request for an extension of time to file the ARF should have been submitted to the Commission prior to the ARF's due date, but it was not.

KRWA and Beech Grove entered into a written agreement dated August 4, 2026, for KRWA to prepare the ARF. Soon after entering into the agreement, KRWA and Beech Grove discovered that an extension of time to file the ARF had not been submitted to the Commission by either party.

Beech Grove now comes to the Commission to request an extension of time. Specifically, Beech Grove requests that the Commission allow until January 31, 2027, or six months after the original July 31, 2026 due date, for Beech Grove to file the required rate documents.
