Dear Mr. Overstreet:

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(3), AT&T Mobility by Petition received September 3, 2013, requested confidential treatment of certain information filed with the Commission outside of a formal proceeding. 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(3)(c), provides that the Commission's "executive director, as official custodian of the commission's records, shall determine if the material is within an exclusion established in KRS 61.878 and the time period for which the material should be considered as confidential and shall advise the requestor of his or her determination by letter." This letter constitutes my determination of your request.

The information you request the Commission treat as confidential is identified as being contained in Attachments A-1 and A-2 to its Certification and Report. The information is described as being the entirety of Attachment A-1, titled as Summary of Potential Capital Projects for 2014; and the entirety of Attachment A-2, titled as the Summary of ETC Expenditures for 2012.

Your justification for having the Public Service Commission handle this material as confidential is that the public disclosure of the information could result in an unfair commercial advantage to competitors.


Based on a review of the information and pursuant to KRS 61.878 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, the information requested to be held confidential is of a proprietary nature, which if publicly disclosed would permit an unfair commercial advantage to AT&T

Mobility's competitors. Therefore, the information requested to be treated as confidential **meets the criteria for confidential protection** and will be maintained as a nonpublic part of the Commission's file in this case for a 10 year period of time from the date of this correspondence, or until further Orders of the Commission. The procedure for usage of confidential materials during formal proceedings may be found at Section 13(9) of 807 KAR 5:001.

If the information becomes publicly available or no longer warrants confidential treatment, AT&T Mobility by Section 13(10)(b) of 807 KAR 5:001 is to inform the Commission so that the information may be placed in the public record.
