In compliance with the Commission's April 12, 2010 Order in KY PSC Case No. 2009-00480, this letter serves as notice of expansion of the Residential White Pages Consumer Choice Initiative (RWPCCI) to directories in four additional markets in AT&T Kentucky's service area. This expansion will be implemented by YP LLC, pursuant to its contract with AT&T Kentucky.

Customers in these markets will receive a directory containing the business White Pages and Yellow Pages. A message box on the front cover of the directory, verbiage within the Customer Guide inside the directory, and a media release will be used to inform both new and existing end-users that they can receive free of charge a residential White Pages directory at any time by simply calling a toll-free number. Additionally, end users can access the white pages online at the link provided in the Real Yellow Pages.

The directories and implementation dates are:

- Richmond Directory – January 2016 (includes Berea, Ford, Kirksville, Paint Lick & Waco)
- Greater Ohio Valley Area Directory – February 2016 (includes Calhoun, Hardinsburg, Hartford, Hawesville, Owensboro, Beaver Dam, Centertown, Cloverport, Ensor, Fordsville, Habit, Island, Livermore, Maceo, McDaniels, Panther, Pleasant Ridge, Sacramento, Sorgho, Stanley, Utica, West Louisville and Whitesville)
- Henderson-Union County-Webster County-Marion-Princeton Directory – March, 2016 (includes Clay, Corydon, Dixon, Eddyville, Fredonia, Hebbardsville, Kuttawa, Providence, Robards, Salem, Sebree, Slaughters, Sturgis, Uniontown & Waverly)
- Madisonville-Muhlenberg Co. Directory – March 2016 (includes Bremen, Central City, Dawson Springs, Drakesboro, Earlington, Greenville, Hanson, Mortons Gap, Nebo, Nortonville, St. Charles and White Plains)
