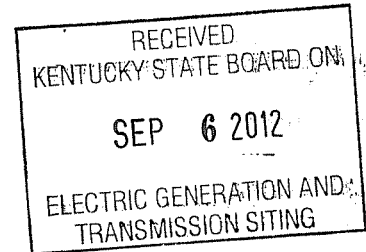


RE: Additional Information by Southern Indiana Gas & Electric Co. d/b/a Vectren Energy Delivery of Indiana, Inc. in Request for Flexibility to Address Unanticipated Construction Issues Pursuant to Order of the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting, Case No. 2010-00223

Dear Mr. Derouen:

By letter dated July 11, 2012, Southern Indiana Gas & Electric Co., d/b/a Vectren Energy Delivery of Indiana ("Vectren"), requested Board approval for a minor modification of the route for construction of a 345 kV non-regulated transmission line to take a small portion of the line outside the 1,000 feet corridor approved by the Siting Board in the above referenced case. The preliminary analysis contained in that letter indicated that the modified route would eliminate two stream crossings. Upon completed analysis and after consultation with the US Army Corp of Engineers and the Kentucky Division of Water, the modified route will in fact still cross two ephemeral streams and one perennial stream, as indicated in the maps filed with the Board on September 5, 2012, and is in the process of being permitted accordingly. As previously indicated, however, the modified route will eliminate three jurisdictional wetlands crossings, and represents a lesser scenic and environmental impact as demonstrated by the letter and supporting maps.
