The Public Service Commission has received the Petition for Confidential Treatment you filed on October 24, 2011 on behalf of Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") to protect certain information filed with the Commission as confidential pursuant to Section 7 of 807 KAR 5:001 and KRS 61.870. The information you seek to have treated as confidential is identified as being contained in KU's Exhibits to the Rebuttal Testimonies of David S. Sinclair and Charles R. Schram. The information is described as Appendix A to both Rebuttal testimonies containing projected fuel prices; Figure 1 and Exhibits DSS-3 and DSS-5 of Sinclair Rebuttal Testimony containing fuel price forecast; and Exhibit CRS-3 of Schram's Rebuttal Testimony containing the reserve margin analysis as part of the 2011 IRP.

Your justification for having the Commission handle this material as confidential is that the public disclosure of the information could result in an unfair commercial advantage to competitors.


