
Dear Ms. Bridwell:

In Case No. 2012-00169, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) approved the request of East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC”) to transfer functional control of its transmission system to PJM Interconnection, LLC (“PJM”). As part of the approval, the Commission required EKPC to submit an annual report of its activities in PJM on or before May 31<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year. Because PJM utilizes a June 1<sup>st</sup> to May 31<sup>st</sup> Delivery Year to operate its markets, EKPC requested in Case No. 2015-00116 – and the Commission approved in a May 14, 2015 Order – a deferred annual filing deadline of July 31<sup>st</sup>, so that the entire year of PJM data could be presented at the same time.

More recently, in Case No. 2021-00103, EKPC requested to be relieved of the reporting requirement established in Case No. 2012-00169. The Commission denied this request and also revised the filing date from July 31<sup>st</sup> back to May 31<sup>st</sup>. By returning to the May 31<sup>st</sup> deadline, EKPC will be unable to provide data for an entire PJM Delivery Year. Accordingly, EKPC respectfully requests the Commission to move the filing deadline for this Annual Report in this year and all subsequent years back to July 31<sup>st</sup>. This will allow EKPC to adequately capture a full year’s worth of PJM operating data. Deferring the reporting deadline back to July 31<sup>st</sup> will also allow EKPC to provide a more comprehensive picture of its operations in PJM. Moreover, no party interested in this information would be prejudiced by a brief delay in filing the Annual Report.
