Dear Mr. Greynolds:

Your electronic mail to Linda Faulkner of August 13, 2014 indicates that the water district has \$450,000 remaining from funds for a project granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") in a June 7, 2013 Order issued in Case No. 2013-00155.<sup>1</sup> In the June 7, 2013 Order, East Casey County Water District ("East Casey District") was also authorized to execute an Assistance Agreement with the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority ("KIA") to borrow an amount not to exceed \$1,545,000.

According to your electronic mail, East Casey District intends to use the remaining funds for a new pump station and to purchase radio read meters. The project description in East Casey District's application in Case No. 2013-00155 does not include a new pump station or the purchase of radio read meters.

Ordering Paragraph 10 of the June 7, 2013 Order in Case No. 2013-00155 states:

East Casey District shall use the proceeds from the proposed Assistance Agreement with KIA only for the lawful purposes set forth in its application.
