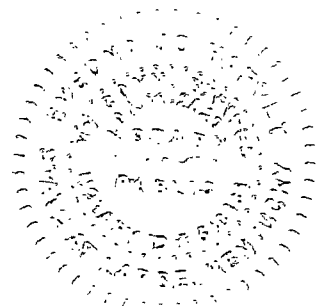

On April 8, 2015, Magoffin County Water District ("Magoffin District") applied to the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSG") for authority to adjust its rates for water service. The initial proposed effective date of the requested rate adjustment was made pursuant to the date of an Order granting an increase by the PSG. After performing a review of Magoffin District's application and records, the PSG Staff has recommended to the PSG that Magoffin District adjust its rates to their retail customers that are different from those proposed by Magoffin District. 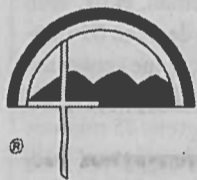
