In regards to KPSC Order of 12/23/2015 in Case 2015-00301 that pertains to the transfer of Troublesome Creek Environmental Authority, Inc to Knott County Water and Sewer District, the Highway 80 project was officially closed on May 31, 2018. The project installed 66,000 linear feet of line, 32 grinder pumps, 8,000 linear feet of service line, 4 lift stations and 2 gravity manholes. It provided service to Jamestown Village Mobile Home Park and to a section of Phoenix Place effectively decommissioning one package treatment plant. The project also provided service to residents along Highway 80. Upon completion of construction the project assets were transferred to Knott County Water and Sewer District to own, operate and maintain.
