TO 4:30 P.M., E.T.; AND (III) VIJ. THE PSC WEBSITE AT HTTP://PSC.KY.GOV. COMMENTS REGARDING THE APPLICATION MAY BE SUBMITTED TO THE PSC VIA ITS WEBSITE OR BY MAIL TO PSC, P.O. BOX 615, FRANKFORT KENTUCKY 40602.

THE PROPOSED RATES ARE REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THI DISTRICT AND RD AND KRS 278.023 DOES NOT GRANT THE PSC ANY DISCRETIONARY AUTHORIT TO MODIFY OR REJECT ANY PORTION OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DISTRICT AND RC OR TO DEFER THE ISSUANCE OF ALL NECESSARY ORDERS TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT. THE RD LOAN PROCEEDS WILL BE USED TO FINANCE THE COSTS OF (INSTALLING APPROXIMATELY 10,400 LF OF 8", 11,900 LF OF 6", 7,230 LF OF 4", 2,100 LF OF 2 WATER MAIN, AND ALL RELATED APPURTENANCES FROM STEARNS TO SMITHTOWN ALONG K. HWY 92, KY HWY 791 AND NEAR THE SKULLBONE WATER STORAGE TANK; (II) IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CHEMICAL ROOM AT THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT; AND (III) NEW SERVICE LINE TO CONNECT EXISTING METERS.
